TEAL Certificate Basics

- Four courses (12 credits)
- Each course is 12 weeks (approx. 3 hrs /wk) or 6 weeks (6 hours/wk)
- Complete in one to six years
- Start in September & January (12 weeks), May & July (6 weeks)
- Asynchronous / online at own pace with deadlines
- Take courses in any order
- May take just one or two courses
- TQS approved (12 credits can go toward 5+ and 6 credits toward Masters Degree)
- Cost is \$650 after you opt out of sports, bus pass, medical and student union (Scott said he can do if in a cohort)
- SD23 is working on contributing to the cost in some way.
- The TEAL is recognized worldwide, and you can teach K-12, post-secondary & overseas.

- Practicum in Additional Language Teaching and Learning (will now be able to do in your own practice)

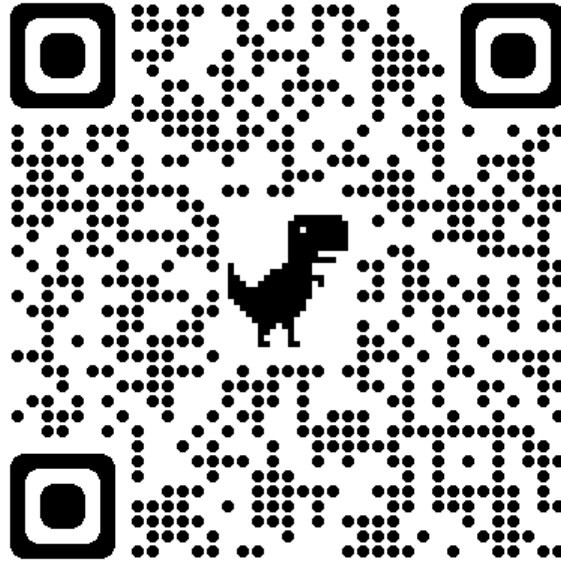

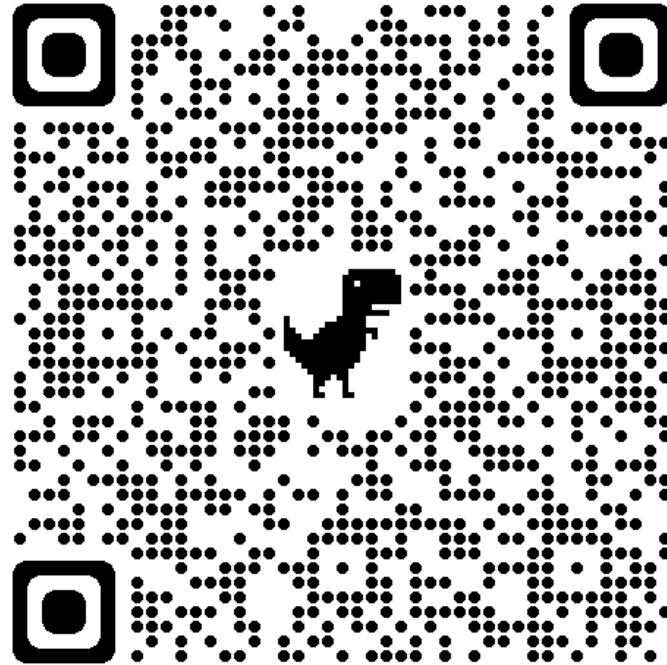
